
## Small Group Information:

Devotional/Prayer: A. W. Tozer – Church Organization

Titus 1:5 – The reason I left you in Crete was that you might put in order what was left unfinished and appoint elders in every town, as I directed you.

There is a tendency to over-organize the church. We know we can't oppose organization in the church any more than we can perish from too much organization. However, we must find a balance between the two extremes and avoid both.

Tozer prays, "Give us wisdom, Lord, to operate with good organization and wise business practices. But keep us from being so organized that the Holy Spirit has no room to work. Amen."

We want God to be leading our Sunday Services, we don't want to limit the Spirit of God. We must find that delicate balance to lead us and allow holy people to use their gifts (as mentioned in the 3 Sermon Series Discussion "Christian-ish").

Lord, thank you for being here. Please remind us to have a balance of order and structure. We know we need to allow your spirit to move within us. As leaders, give us wisdom and understanding to allow your Holy Spirit amongst us. Thank you for the past year and thank you that you are unchanged. We are looking forward to what works you will do here in 2019 and remain thankful for the blessings of 2018. We thank you also Lord for all those that have served within this body this past year in so many ways.

Secretary Report - Dan made a motion to accept the October 15, 2018 minutes and Chris seconded that motion. No discussion, motion carried.

Treasurer's Report - The beginning balance in the checking account was \$62,161.66 with deposits of \$355,410.56 for a total of \$417,572.22. Year to date expenses were \$359,619.61, leaving a balance in checking as of November 30, 2018, of \$57,952.61. Free Methodist Loan Fund is \$51,511.69 and the local Savings Account balance is \$11,811.72. Traci made a motion to accept the September Treasurer's Report and Chris seconded that motion. No discussion, motion carried.

### Old Business:

Class Room Dividers – A plan has been made to install/put in place the dividers. It will take a couple of Saturdays to implement this plan.

2019 Budget – Dan made a motion, seconded by Traci to approve the proposed 2019 budget and present it at the annual meeting.

### New Business:

Val Johnson – Val informed the board that she would be resigning as All-in Director. She will be stepping down from the Children's Program at the end of May. Val and Wayne were thanked for their years of service to our Wednesday Night Children's Ministry.

Salik Building Project – After much discussion the board agree to present Salik with the money available to us in the Free Methodist Foundation Fund to go towards his building project. The motion was made by Craig and seconded by Chris. No further discussion, motion carried.

C.A.R.E. Ministries – Discussed giving extra to this ministry. It was determined that we will continue on with our annual dues.

Ark Encounter Trip – Request to look into a Diamond Tour Bus Trip to Kentucky for a 7 day/6 night package. Cost would be \$649.00 based on double occupancy. Price would include pick up from Motley Free Methodist Parking lot, lodging, most meals, and all admission costs. A minimum of 30 people would need to be interested, but could be combined with other groups interested. Looking to set up in the fall of 2019. Watch in the bulletin for more information.

Year End Giving – A motion was made by Craig and seconded by Dan to give out \$12,000 in year-end giving to various different organizations and ministries.

Watch Night Service – To be held on New Year's Eve. Meet together at the church for fellowship and reconciliation. Enjoy pizza and games and then together we will watch Billy Graham, An Extraordinary Journey on DVD. The evening will end with a communion service. Let's pray our way into the New Year.

Membership Approval – Dan made a motion, seconded by Chris to approve a person for membership.

Nominating Committee – The board discussed board positions coming available and reviewed/approved the names provided by the Nominating Committee to prepare for the upcoming Annual Meeting.
