## Small Group Information:

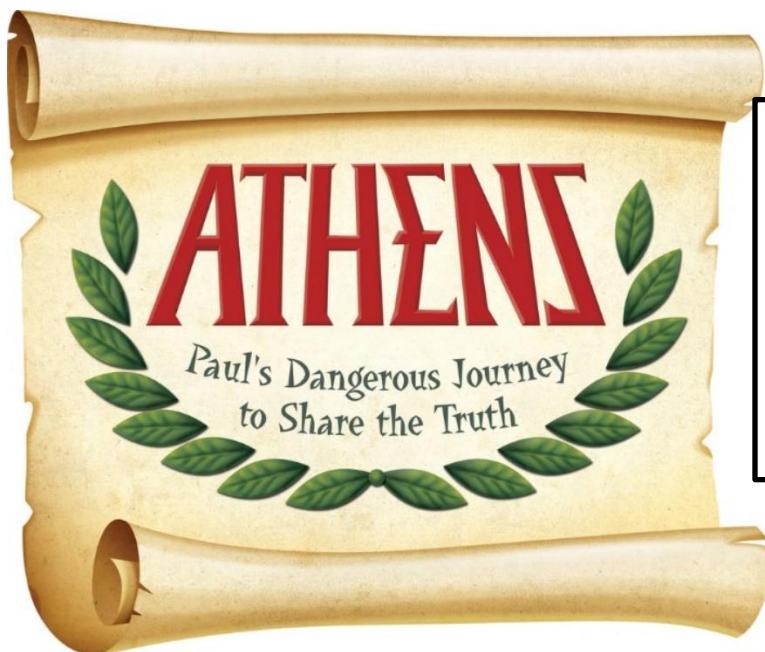

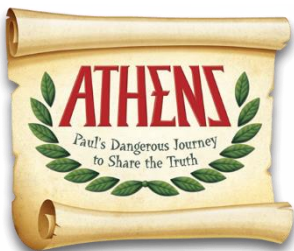

## BOA MINUTES – 5/20/2019

**Present:** Dan Rose, Ian Newkirk, Traci Birkholtz, Wayne Johnson, Tim Judd, Linda Beebe, Pastor Charles Mallory, Mary Duberowski and Susie Griffith

**Guests:** Val Johnson, Jessica Judd, and Craig Weigel  
Devotional/Prayer

Secretary Report - Tim made a motion to accept the April 15, 2019 Minutes, Susie seconded that motion. No discussion, motion carried.

Treasurer's Report – The beginning balance in the checking account was \$54,851.37 with deposits of \$35,555.17 for a total of \$90,406.54. Expenses were \$21,358.76 leaving a balance in checking as of April 30, 2019, of \$69,047.78. Our Motley Savings Account balance is \$11,814.67. After various questions and answers, Ian made a motion to accept the April Treasurer's Report and Traci seconded that motion. All agreed, motion carried.

### **Old Business:**

Annual Conference Update – Held May 31 – June 1, 2019. The parties will leave on Thursday, May 30<sup>th</sup>. Jennifer will be approved as CMC at the Annual Conference.

Kid's Club/Awana– Val provided an informational handout with All-In data for the 2018/2019 year.

Traci told the board start-up costs are approximately \$30 per child and she informed them of an upcoming volunteer meeting being scheduled for this week. This number includes books, awards, t-shirts, etc. Ian made a motion to pay up to \$30 per child for starting up the Awana Club and Tim seconded that motion. All agreed, motion carried.

Youth Group Motley Missions Project – There is currently no start date set up for the Ernie Converse Park project. The youth is still providing the \$9000 donation originally offered. The City of Motley is looking into various grants and waiting on an RFQ at this time.

Church Shirts – Val provided a digital sample of a logo for the board's approval prior to getting samples. The t-shirts will cost approximately \$14 with the golf shirts costing approximately \$21-\$26. The board agreed to move forward with the printing of sample shirt(s) to offer to the church body.

Cahill's Visit – After visiting with them, Dan and Mary commented that this couple is truly committed to their ministry. A pamphlet was handed out containing their needs (financial, material and prayerful). They are looking to secure funds for their return trip to Tanzania.

Dan brought up that Child Hope Ministry (a ministry that was originally started by both Dan and Marie Rose and one in which we currently contribute to) has secured new investors who are greatly contributing to their cause. He thought it would be worthwhile to transfer our contributions from Child Hope Ministry to The Cahills.

After much discussion (question and answers), a motion was made by Ian and seconded by Wayne to terminate our Child Hope contributions and transfer our balance of approximately \$1,125.00 to the Cahills in addition to our current support. All agreed, motion carried.

### **New Business:**

Chaplain (Todd County) Support – A motion was made by Traci to support the Todd County Chaplain in the same amount (\$1000) as last year, Susie seconded that motion. All agreed, motion carried.

New Members – Of the 18 people that attended the Membership Class, five have returned applications to become members at Motley Free Methodist Church. After the board reviewed the five applications Traci made a motion to accept the applicants and Susie seconded that motion. No discussion, motion carried.

VBS – Jess reported that all positions have been filled. Donations are still needed. The next VBS meeting will be held on June 8<sup>th</sup>. Registration will need to be pushed at this point. Set up will begin on June 13<sup>th</sup>.

Swim Program Request – Val made a request to help local children attend the Staples Summer Swim Program. Traci made a motion to support this in the amount of \$350 (the same amount as last year). Wayne seconded the motion. All agreed, motion carried.

Policy for Adult Education – The board had a discussion regarding volunteer roles within the church. It was stated that it has been our policy in the past, that volunteers be a part of our church for approximately six months prior to taking on roles within the church.

Video Capabilities – We need new cable installed. We are currently waiting on a quote for that. More decisions need to be made on where to run it. Discussion has been tabled until a quote has been provided.

Bishop Hawkin's Visit – The Bishop would like to come to present on Kenya and to preach on the Great Commission on June 9, 2019. He is asking for support in lodging, meals, and entertainment while he is here and also for assistance in traveling to his next destination. More information is needed at this time before decisions can be made.

Weekly Scripture Reading – The board feels it would be worthwhile to add some sort of weekly scriptural memorization/reading challenges to our church family. Different ideas were: Adding it to the bulletin, adding it on the big screen, in the newsletter or possibly an insert.

### Other

-Tim made a motion to buy a new industrial strength vacuum cleaner to replace the current one (which is no longer working). Ian seconded that motion. All agreed, motion carried.

Next meeting is scheduled for June 24, 2019

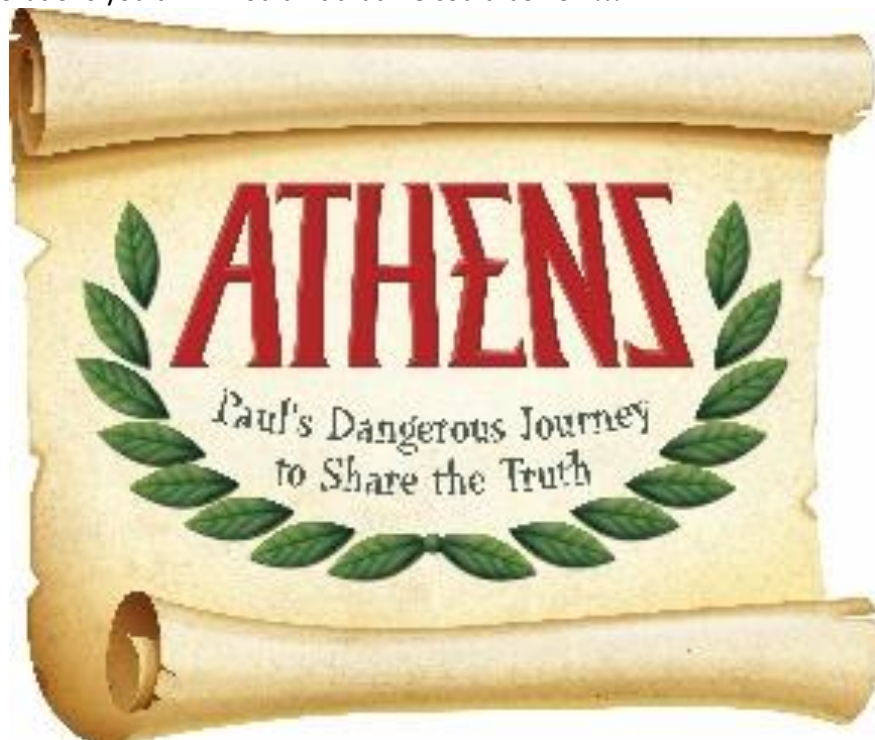
