A Few Words from Pastor Jim:

This month the weather has been challenging for all of us! Our movie night took place the first week, many families stayed but the snow kept coming down and families trickled out throughout the night to get home before roads were bad.

Our current unit is: "Who is My Neighbor?"- this particular unit really ties into what most of us focus on the month of February, "Love". We learned from Pastor Jim who our neighbor was, anyone that we encounter in our day, and we learned that when we know Jesus and love Him, obeying Him becomes something we want to do. That we should have a supernatural love flow out of us! Pastor challenged us to show compassion and be kind to someone at school that other kids may leave out. Barb came this last week and she helped us learn about "Getting Along with Others"- We learned about our words and that they should feel like cotton balls to those whom we are talking with. We also learned about serving others, what it really means and what it might look like. Barb's challenge this week is to find an opportunity to serve others.

One of the focal points for our kids program is that all the kids have their own Bible. This last week we gifted each of the kids a new Bible. All the kids received a bag to carry their Bibles in, to help encourage them to bring them each week, chocolate goodies may have been mentioned. They were all very excited and happy with their Bibles, this next week they will each be challenged to take the next 42 days to read through the Gospel of John! March is a pretty quiet month, we will be collecting coins and cans for the food shelf in Motley; and learning more about neighbors, and starting a unit on "How do I Live My Faith?".

Thank you for always praying for us, here are some prayer requests: 1) children and their families, that they will continue to come and have a hunger for God's Word and that God will prepare their hearts to accept Jesus as their Savior. 2)Volunteers- to be healthy, to strengthen and encourage them to love these kids with a supernatural love that only comes from God. 3) God's direction for the remainder of the year and all the special events to be his leading. 4) Safety and 5) Provision for all the things we need on a weekly basis to minister to these kids and their families.

This year's theme is Athens! Mark your calendars for June 17-21, 2019 4:30-7:30 pm! We need you!! 😊



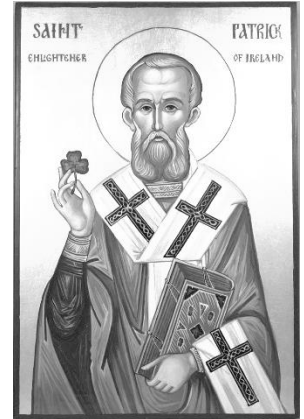
Young Adult Ministries

Treasurer's Report – The beginning balance in the checking account was \$65,968.69 with deposits of \$22,573.26 for a total of \$88,541.95. Year to date expenses were \$26,810.11, leaving a balance in checking as of January 31, 2019, of \$61,731.84. Our Motley Savings Account balance is \$11,811.72.
