Devotional/Prayer: A. W. Tozer – Desperate Personal Search

Mathew 5:16 – In the same way, let your light shine before others, that they may see your good deeds and glorify your Father in heaven.

The average person without faith, God and hope and those who have lost God somewhere along the way are engaged in a desperate search throughout their lifetime. Man, who was made to be like God, has become less like God than ever. Love is gone from our heart and the light is gone from our mind.

Are we a light shining in the dark? Is our light helping others who are struggling in a dark world? Are we being the light? How can we improve? Secretary Report - Craig made a motion to accept the August 20, 2018, minutes and Chris seconded that motion. No further discussion, motion carried.

Treasurer's Report - The beginning balance in the checking account was \$62,161.66 with deposits of \$255,399.19 for a total of \$317,560.85. Year to date expenses were \$252,037.09, leaving a balance in checking as of August 31, 2018, of \$65,523.76. Free Methodist Loan Fund is \$51,098.16 and the local Savings Account balance is \$11,810.23. Dan made a motion to accept the July Treasurer's Report and Traci seconded that motion. No discussion, motion carried.

Old Business:

Dividers – The dividers are here and ready to be installed.

Set Free Sunday – Ashley will be picked up and housed by Mary. We will have a potluck on Sunday after the second service.

New Business:

Faith Community Nursing – A program Jen Michalson is interested in starting up. It is for nurses who have specialized education in spiritual care and ministry. To be considered for a scholarship, she would need Pastor Jim to send a letter of intent in partnering with her. Chris made a motion agreeing to a Letter of Recommendation/Intent for scholarship and Dan seconded.

Kids Club – Registration Night drew 40 kids. Board agreed to having "church" t-shirts that could be used for All-In as well as other events. T-shirts would be open to all for purchase. Val will get samples and a design will be picked out.

A Community Based Trunk or Treat event will be held at Motley Middle School Parking Lot on October 27, 2018. Board has opted out of participating in this event.

Pastor Salik – will be here on October 28. Dan and Marie will pick him up and house him. Pastor Jim will be at the Des Moines District Meeting from October 27 through October 28.

19-30 Year Old Bible Study – Pastor Charles is looking at new curriculum to go along with the Soul Detox. After a starting date and a meeting place is determined, handouts will be made and promotions (Twitter, Facebook, and Staples World) will begin.

2019 Budget – The 2019 budget will be finalized by October or November's BOA meeting. We will need to know if all board members plan on returning again next year.

Thanksgiving Service – At this time we do not plan on joining Faith Lutheran in hosting the Thanksgiving Service. We have very few members/worshippers that attend. We will have our own Thanksgiving service here on Sunday evening November 18th.

Tent City – Insurance would cover this event for our youth to be held here at church. The City of Motley has no problem with it and will work with police staff for extra patrols in the area during that event as well. Youth would raise money for the entrance fee as a donation to New Pathways. This would be held on Friday, October 19th (over MEA weekend). Motion made by Traci to allow this event to be held here at church during said time, Craig seconded that motion. No discussion, motion carried.

Fall Festival – More volunteers are needed, many slots are available for helpers to sign up. We could use more food/ice cream as well.
