A Few Words from Pastor Jim:

2 Timothy 4:3-5 *"For the time will come when men will not put up with sound doctrine. Instead to suit their own desires, they will gather around them a great number of teachers to say what their itching ears want to hear. They will turn their ears away from the truth and turn aside to myths. But you, keep your head in all situations...."*

The Apostle Paul gives this sound advice to Timothy and the advice is legitimate for today as well.

Fellow brothers and sisters in Jesus Christ, we must read and know the scriptures. All people, including us in the church, can be persuaded and / or convinced of a false doctrine or a false teaching or what the "majority" is saying if we are not aware of what the Word of God says.

Paul reminds us that the time will come, and may be here now, when people will not even want to know or want to hear the truth but rather want to hear something other than the truth.

This seems hard to imagine perhaps for us, but I see this happening all the time. It seems like folks are less concerned about absolute truth today then ever before. May we immerse ourselves in God's word and be led by God's Spirit and know the truth and not have anything to do with false doctrines that are popping up all over the place, it seems. Jesus said to His followers, you shall know the truth and the truth shall set you free.....to which I say Hallelujah.

If you are not in a weekly bible study group somewhere (here or otherwise) why don't you consider the opportunities that we provide to you to grow and learn in a bible study. Starting with Sunday morning at 10:30 am, there are a lot of different studies and opportunities to grow and learn. Thank you, teachers and leaders, for providing all of these learning opportunities.

Can you believe that it is almost Labor Day already? Where did the summer go? Wasn't it just last week it was late April and still snowing like crazy? Life is like that, it can go by so quickly and then it is gone. Have you made plans for eternity friends? We plan for vacation, we plan for going to work, we plan for winter, we plan for fun.... have we planned for eternity by surrendering our lives completely to Jesus the Christ?

If Pastor Charles or I can help you with that please let us know.

Labor Day and September means, it is time again for school and Kids club and all kinds of fall events.

In Children's Ministry News:

The children's ministry will see a few changes as we head into September!

Nursery Care will remain the same during both services for children 0-3 years of age, but we are still in need of more volunteers who are interested in helping with our little ones. If you are interested please talk with Linda Beebe!

Children's Church is during our first service each week. The children dismiss during the sermon to go have their own Bible story lesson with Sheri Johnson and help.

The biggest changes are taking place in our Sunday school classes. It is September and children are changing grades and we are going back to having four Sunday School classes starting Sept. 2, 2018. The preschool-Kindergarten teacher will remain the same with Jason Caldwell and Logan Michalson but they will be moving classrooms to the back room. The 1st-2nd grade class will be taught by Jennifer Mallory, who is still in need of an assistant, if any one is interested please see Jessica Judd. This class will meet in the current pre-K room. The 3rd-4th Grade class will be led by Grace Johnson and Brenda Romig. They will meet in the big area. 5th-6th grade will temporarily meet in the back-corner room, until our new basement accordion door divider arrives at which time they will meet on one end of the basement and the 3rd and 4th graders will meet on the opposite end. When this happens our youth class will begin to meet during the second service in the back-corner room as well. This will allow for all our children/youth Sunday school classes to be held at the same time!! All of our children are using the Bible In-Life curriculum this fall for Sunday School. We are 2 weeks away from kick-off night! And we are looking to fill in some volunteer roles!

- Do like to help organize kick-ball or other large group games to teach kids skills like teamwork and looking for a short time commitment each Wednesday- We are looking for **1-2 people** who would like to help organize our **Game Activities** each week from 4:05 to 4:25
- Another short time commitment from approx. 4:30-4:50- **Facilitating the Large Group Lesson**- each week the lesson is laid out, with what to talk about and how.... If you have the ability to speak to kids in a way that gets their attention and the desire to help them understand God's Word, this could be the spot for you—we could use 2-3 people willing to rotate to do this 1x every 3-4 weeks.
- **Our 1st and 2nd grade group is looking for more help**- we are looking for **1-2 people** that would be willing to **facilitate small group time**, again what discussion and activities required are provided in plan book. We are also looking for **several people** that would be willing to **help/mentor 1-2 kids in this group** to follow along with the facilitator (i.e., find Bible Scripture in Bible, help complete activities in Handbook, spend time each week with assigned children praying and just having conversation) This is a bigger time commitment, 3:30ish to 5:30

What do we do each week???? Every week the kids come after school, if they are at the Middle School they walk over with 2 volunteers, Staples Elementary kids ride a bus, along with a volunteer from church, and are dropped off at the door of the church, Pillager students are picked up by 2 volunteers in our church van. *(If you would be willing to be on a sub list to help fill in when help is needed for these areas, let us know)*. After they arrive here at the church, we feed them a light supper (another opportunity for you to be involved!), then we open our time up with Songs and Prayer, dismiss for Game Time where kids play upstairs (loud and active) or downstairs (board games and quieter). After Game time our 1st-6th graders come back together for Large Group time, learn the weekly lesson and then dismiss to Small Group time, where Grade Levels split up around the building to discuss more about the weekly lesson and learn application and memory verse. We then close out our night with joining up in the sanctuary with a song and prayer!

There really are many opportunities to use your gifts and talents with the kids in our community and to show them the LOVE OF JESUS through this ministry! Sign up today to help!

Devotional/Prayer

Heb 11:1 – Faith is the confidence that what we hope for will actually happen; it gives us assurance about things we cannot see.

The voice of the unbeliever says “Yes, I am a believer. I believe in the bible, I believe in God and I believe He will bless some other people, some other place, some other time”. By thinking this unbelief, we are bringing the work of God to a halt in these people, in these places, at this time. At what level is our faith, what level do we really trust in Him? Chronic unbelief does not know what faith really means.

Lord, we claim these three words: **now, here, and us**. We pray we have true belief. Amen.

Secretary Report - Charlie made a motion to accept the August 20, 2018, minutes and Dan seconded that motion. No further discussion, motion carried.

Treasurer's Report - The beginning balance in checking account of \$62,161.66 with deposits of \$227,263.74 for a total of \$289,425.40. Year to date expenses were \$209,236.19, leaving a balance in checking as of July 31, 2018, of \$80,189.21. Free Methodist Loan Fund is \$51,098.16 and the local Savings Account balance is \$11,810.23. Traci made a motion to accept the July Treasurer's Report and Mary seconded that motion. No discussion, motion carried.

Old Business:

Van Use Policy – This policy is already in place. We will implement a log book for mileage and oil changes. Pastoral Group will decide if any requests made to use the van are church events or they will bring the request to the board if they feel necessary.

New Business:

Letter of Resignation – Charlie Poulton submitted his letter of resignation tendering his and Estelle's duties within the church. Their absence will be a huge loss to the church and the many ministries they serve here at MFMC. We wish them many blessings in finding a new church family as they relocate to North Carolina.

Classroom Dividers – The order for classroom dividers have already been placed and Tim Judd will be in charge of installing/setting in place.

Potluck Picnic at The Rose Ranch – On September 2nd after the second service, Marie and Dan Rose will host a “Pigroast” Potluck to welcome the Mallorys' to our church family.

Set Free Movement – Ashley will speak here on Sept 30 to discuss Set Free Sunday and tell us her story. We will plan a potluck that day after the second service.

Badge Sunday – We will not have a Badge Sunday this year, but will consider this event again next year.

Pastor Salik – On October 28 Pastor Salik will be here to speak. We currently send \$1000.00 monthly to support his ministry.

Henriette Free Methodist Church – Our sister church near Hinckley did not have flood insurance. They have currently received \$5,000 in donations towards the 30K – 40K needed to rebuild/replace their belongings. After much discussion the board made a motion to donate \$10,000. First motion made by Tim, seconded by Dan. All agreed, motion carried.

Bible Study for 19-30 Year Olds – Pastor Charles discussed starting a new bible study geared towards millennials. The curriculum (Soul Detox) discusses ways to “detox” from worldly thinking and socialization. Different ideas were discussed to promote this upcoming bible study along with various ways/locations to reach this age group.

Seal Coat the Parking Lot – The board agrees to get an estimate to seal coat, fill in cracks and re-stripe the parking lot.

Tent City – There is not a local event this year for our youth to attend Tent City. Jess would like to put one on here at MFMC or (depending on number of attendees) at the Motley Fairgrounds. She would like to hold this during MEA weekend. Jess will be in contact with the City of Motley for their approval, possible sponsorship and security. The youth would have to raise participation money to donate towards New Pathways. Updates and more discussion will take place at the September board meeting.
