A Few Words from Pastor Jim:

Acts 6:3-4 "Therefore brethren, seek out among you seven men of good reputation, full of the Holy Spirit and wisdom, whom we may appoint over this business; but we will give ourselves continually to prayer and the ministry of the word".

You remember this story from Acts 6? The Hellenists were upset because their widows, seemingly, were being neglected in the daily distribution. And the answer from the Disciples was simply, "it is not desirable that we should leave the word of God and serve tables".

That is where verses 3 and 4 come into play.

What does this mean for us at MFMC? We too have widows; lots of them. We too want to take care of them and visit them and check in on them from time to time and make sure they are ok. They may need a ride to the Dr or the dentist or the grocery. They made need someone to talk to. But we do want to be intentional about looking after them. The scriptures instruct us on such matters.

So, what does that mean? We would like to have a leader with a team to help over see this group of people.

The leader will keep the records of widows and keep a record of important dates. The leader with the help of a team of 6-8 others will also check with these widows and see what their needs are and help them get to where they need to be and maybe just stop for a prayer and a visit from time to time.

Are you interested in being a part of this team? We sure could use you and your help. NO ONE will have to do it all, a team will help make sure it is done. We would like to put this team into place yet this fall. Please let Linda Beebe or Jim know if you would be willing to be part of that team and we will train and pray and "appoint you over this business".

You may or may not be aware of this, but we have around 35 widows here among us. I believe that it would be a beautiful thing for us to be able to minister to widows outside of the church family, at some point, too and maybe tell them about Jesus. What do you think? Will you pray about this? Will you help?

Awana is already upon us again. Praise the Lord we get to minister to our communities' children. We need your help! I hope that you saw the nice presentation that Jennifer Mallory did a couple of weeks ago speaking to the needs for Awana. Will you pray about this too friends? We cannot do any of these ministries without the body functioning as a "body". Remember 1 Corinthians 12?

Have you got a heart to disciple others? Would you like to be trained to disciple others? You recall; once Jesus disciplined the 12, He commissioned them to "go and make more disciples". We need to do the same. Disciple making is intentional too. It will not happen on its own. We have a number of new believers among us right now, they all need to be mentored and disciplined. I am going to do what I can for them, would you like to help? Please let me know if you want further training in disciple making and we will help, so you can be that disciple maker too. And, please let me know if you would like to mentor one of these new believers.

Lastly, do you like to pray? The church of Jesus Christ needs to pray, and prayer needs to be intentional. I love this quote from former Editor of the Light and Life Magazine and Pastor Doug Newton "we pray because God deserves our praise" and "Prayer is where we join God in speaking His will into existence". I will explain that further in today's message.

Will you commit to pray friends? Pray for America, revival, the church. Pray for the lost to come to faith in Jesus Christ. Pray that we (MFMC) will do God's will. Pray for our children and families and the leaders of the nation as well as the church. Pray for young families, pray for the sick and those that have lost their loved ones.

Oh, people of God may we pray like never before and like eternity depends on it.

Friends and people of God; if the church is not intentional about speaking to others the good news of Jesus Christ and if the church is not intentional about making disciples, or loving our neighbors and being "salt and light". The church will soon cease to exist.

People of God, the American church is slipping away. You may think that is being over dramatic, but please inform yourselves on what is happening with the church of America. It is slowly dying. We need revival of the Holy Ghost kind. Only God can do that.

God can and may bring new life.....but not unless we, His people, humble ourselves and pray and seek His face and repent of our sins / turn from our wicked ways. That is His people He is directing to do that. Only then will God forgive us and heal our land.

Friends, let's pray, let's fast, lets seek His face, lets be the hands and feet of Jesus in a whole new way while there is still time.

Personally, I want to do all I can for His Kingdom and His glory, but imagine what would happen when hundreds of us avail ourselves to the work of the Kingdom, to the glory of God.

Devotional/Prayer—Charles Mallory read from 2 Timothy 1:7 For God did not give us a spirit of timidity, but a spirit of power, of love and of self-discipline. Also, reading from Henry Blackaby, stating that the only fear for a Christian should be the fear of God and not a fear of man. Fear does not come for God. God gave us the Holy Spirit to guide us. Trials and persecutions can cause doubt where fears of the unknown can become overwhelming. Pastor said that through prayer we should ask God to give us the wisdom of discernment. His prayer quoted St. John Viannay—“...love God till the last breath of my life.” Sec. Report—Motion to accept by Marisela Vasquez, second by Chris Neal. Motion Carries
Treasurer Report—presented by Linda Beebe. Motion to accept by Barbara H., second by Craig Weigel. Motion carries.

Old Business:

- **Awana Fall Schedule**—no updates
- **Fall Festival**—Discussed with Jessica Judd. Start of Awana kickoff. There are still needs for food/candies for Fall Festival. A Bouncy House has been donated to the church.
- **Kitchen Upgrade**—no update.
- **Youth Mission Trip Update**—Craig Weigel intends to speak to the Mission Site team leader and higher ups about their recent negative experiences at the Youth Works Mission Trip. He will be looking into other options for next year. Overall, the youth had good experiences providing service work and being exposed to many different people. Chris Neal asked about the possibility about doing our own mission trip. The response was that it takes a lot of work.

New Business:

- **Lutheran Social Service Request**—Request for donations at Staples Site to help feed seniors in Staples/Motley. No contact # was left for a follow up. Put on hold until further information is provided.

Keeping the Thing the, “Main Thing”

- **Widows Ministry**—discussed a possible church presentation sometime in September. Linda B. has accumulated possible presentation material. Jess Judd suggested starting a card ministry for widows. Chris Neal suggested that the church get a head of Dept. person. Pastor Jim Johnson wants us to be intentional with outreach.
- **Millennial Outreach**—Pastor spoke about the need to brainstorm and form an intentional outreach to gather the Millennial back into the church. He said, “If we don’t intentionally outreach the Millennial and Generation Z, the church will cease to exist.” The board discussed how to draw these age groups back. Charles stated that they dynamics of family have changed. There are single women and younger adults with kids... Suggestions were—Go to them, pray about it, use the Awana Program to bring young parents in.
- **The Church has an ultimate goal to make disciples.** Bible Studies are not necessarily intentional in making disciples. We need to keep praying and thinking about it.
- **NCC Meeting**—Dale Leehy and Jennifer Mallory will be ordained. Three Delegates are attending; Marisela Vasquez, Linda Beebe, and Carol Weigel. There will be a total of thirteen church (MFMC) people attending.
- **Pastor Jim Johnson Vacation**—August 30th-September 13th the pastor will be out of the office.
- **Badge Sunday**—September 19th, will serve a meal after the second service. A Token of appreciation will be presented before the congregation at both services. Gift Cards will be presented for a \$25.00 to Bricks. Motion made by Craig Weigel, second by Marisela Vasquez.
- **Other**—1. We will be putting Bibles and Hymnals back in the sanctuary. 2. Craig Weigel and Jessica Judd voiced concerns for the youth who are turning 19 or graduating from High School and still want to attend Youth Group. The church policies will be reviewed and distributed to BOA, by Pastor Jim and an amendment may be made at the Sept. BOA meeting.
